The Collaboration between MU and HU schools of education have designed an annual two weeks program that gives students an opportunity to jointly develop innovative and modern learning tools for the Kenyan secondary school classrooms. This year the project involves 14 visiting students from HU and 14 students from MU who will work together to develop the tools collaboratively and use them to teach in four neighboring schools namely; St. Catherine Girls' Secondary School, Lelmolok High School, Terige Boys Secondary School and Our Lady of Victory- Kapnyeberai from 20th May to 2nd June, 2018.

The project is coordinated by Sally Elizabeth Ribnick and Frans Kriger from HU and Dr. Njeri Kiarita and Dr. Lazarus Momanyi from Moi University School of Education. The partnership between MU and HU has been running since 2007 when the first MoU was signed and it has used different avenue to create opportunities for student exchanges, staff exchanges, knowledge sharing and intercultural exchanges.
