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

## RESEARCH DATA IN ACCs

- AIM: Input and search data within ACCs
- Browse through data across disciplines to enrich research direction with new insights and to address related research questions
- Collaborative research in African studies
  - connecting a wide range of academic disciplines;
  - building an innovative digital research environment;



#### What Data?

- Video and voice recordings
- Questionnaires and interview transcripts
- Test results held in text files and spreadsheets
- Archive materials and handwritten notes
- Code and software
- Photographs and slides
- Laboratory notebooks





## Why Manage Research Data?


- Efficiency and ease of data control, with reduced risk of data loss
- Greater visibility of data, leading to increased citations and future collaborations
- Demostration of research integrity and validation of research results
- Compliance with funder and institutional policies and expectations
- Greater impact of research through knowledge transfer
- Research advances through reuse of data by researchers within the clusters / world

ORCID for cluster researchers! (also needed in the linked data element metadata) & Set up a digital scholarship awareness scheme within the cluster



#### Why DSPace?

- Can handle
  - Pre-prints, articles
  - <sup>~</sup> Postprints
  - Technical reports
  - Conference papers / presentations
  - Theses/Dissertations
  - Datasets e.g statistics, geospatial, scientific



### Why DSPace?

- Standards
  - Dublin Core
  - OAI-PMH (Open Archives Initiative Protocol for Metadata Harvesting)
  - UNICODE

It has capabilities to support other standards such as: METS (Metadata Encoding and Transmission Standard) and MODS (Metadata Object Description Schema)



#### Why DSPace?

- Searchable and indexed by major search engines including Google Scholar.
- Already registered in the Directory of Open Access Repositories (DOAR)
- Link to ORCID (Open Research and Contributor ID)





## **Current Situation @ MU**

- Currenly using DSpace version 6.3 need to upgrade to 7.4
- Implement the common Dspace 7.4 matadata schema
- Migrate local data to Dspace community space
- Need to constitute a new working group involving ACC PIs and Data Management / Repository staff
- Review IR Policy to include Research Data





## Current Situation @ MUACC

- Conference / workshop presentations are uploaded as book of abstracts
- Not searchable
- Research data held by individual researchers
- See example





#### Challenges @ MU

- Server space and capabilities
- Need to build capacity on data management and Data curation (most are Information Scientists)

- Find projects to showcase interdisciplinary research possibilities






### 2025 – 2032 Strategy (Establish RDM Unit)

- 1a. <u>Digital Scholarship</u> (scholarly communication, scholarship research, digital artefacts, virtual library, born digital materials, scholarly commons)
- 1b. <u>Digital Research Environment Readiness</u> (Networking, collaboration, data and project management, digital literacy, digital repositories, digital media lab)
- 1c. <u>Digital capacity building</u> at all ACCs that enables both staff and researchers to attain certified skills in research data management (*Under Institute of African Studies?*)
